Dear colleagues,

It is with great pleasure that I write to announce that the next meeting of our Association will take place, in person, between Sunday 20 March and Wednesday 23 March 2022, in parallel with the 144<sup>th</sup> Assembly of the Inter-Parliamentary Union. The meeting will take place at the Bali International Convention Centre (BICC) in Nusa Dua, Indonesia.

Our hosts at the Indonesian Parliament are working diligently on the health measures which will allow this conference to take place, despite the ongoing pandemic conditions related to Covid-19. Further details regarding health measures for the conference will be communicated to you shortly, I know that I can count on all of you to cooperate with these measures to ensure the safety of the meeting.

I would like to draw your attention to the fact that full vaccination will be mandatory for participation at the conference. Social distancing measures will also be in place which may have consequences for the total number of people who are allowed in the ASGP conference room at any one time. I hope to confirm these details shortly.

Please find attached to this email the draft orders of the day for our meetings. The programme remains subject to change, the definitive orders of the day will be adopted during our first full plenary meeting, which will begin at 11am on Monday 21 March. Several general debates will be organised; on the rules regarding travel by Members of Parliament and their allowances, on offering support when Members of Parliament lose, or give up, their seats and on the question of what we expect of a Secretary-General in the 21st century.

Communications, relating to the conference themes of current affairs, the place of soft law in society and the renovation of parliamentary buildings, or on a new subject, are very welcome. Please send proposals for communications to Elektra Garvie-Adams before 28 February 2022.

Finally, I can also announce that several elections will be organised during this session in order to fill a post of Vice-President of the Association and several posts as ordinary members of the Executive Committee. Members who are unable to attend the Nusa Dua (Bali) session in person, due to travel restrictions, will be allowed to stand as candidates for the vacant posts, following a process which will be set out in more detail in a subsequent note.

For all the practical details regarding the session, I invite you to take time to review the co-secretaries letter. I look forward to reuniting with you all in Nusa Dua (Bali).
