

Offers training programs and other type of educational products to the target groups on a regular basis




To define and develop effective system of continuous learning for target groups




Main topics of the trainings conducted by in-house trainers



Develop new training modules for schoolchildren, students, media, civil society, etc.












































The PTC activities in 2017-2018


There were trained in total 592 MPs and staffers

The PTC activities from 1st January to 30th June 2019


There were conducted 40 trainings with participation of 383 staffers




Male - 143
