The Secretariat of the Senate of the Kingdom of Thailand has taken steps to drive the organization toward becoming a digital parliament by upgrading the agency to serve as a comprehensive hub for providing essential data and documents necessary for the legislative process and the performance of duties by members of the Senate. According to the policies of the President of the Senate and the Secretary-General of the Senate in increasing the capability of convenient and rapid information tracking and document accessing and effective support for the Senate missions, the Secretariat of the Senate also organized an internal innovation contest aiming to find formats or methods to upgrade services and support work that helps create new innovative services for the organization. One of the creative and outstanding innovations that won **the first-prize in the Innovation Awards of the Secretariat of the Senate is "LexiConnect: Integrated Digital Constitution"** by the Bureau of Legal Affairs.

**LexiConnect: Integrated Digital Constitution** is an integration of legal knowledge and academic products for the maximum benefit of users. The innovation aligns with the policy of the Secretary-General of the Senate (**iSenate+**) and the Action Plan of the Secretariat of the Senate. The Bureau of Legal Affairs presented **LexiConnect: Integrated Digital Constitution as a prototype innovation of producing the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, B.E. 2560 (2017) in a Smart Book format**. It is a new presentation of research, collection, analysis and link to information related to important constitutional provisions. This includes objectives or legislative intent, rulings of the Constitutional Court, provisions of Organic Acts and Ordinary Acts, academic articles and interviews on academic opinion with experts. These data sources which were previously scattered are now systematically organized using **Links (symbols)** that connect to various information within each Section of the Constitution. Users do not need to search for further information elsewhere, as it allows them to access online data conveniently, quickly, and comprehensively. This is essential for officials in performing duty more efficiently to support legislative work. **LexiConnect** also supports future development toward **Artificial Intelligence (AI)** technology with the ability to rapidly learn and process data in the future.

**The Secretariat of the Senate** has further developed **LexiConnect: Integrated Digital Constitution** by improving its content for better completion and accuracy. The

working group of LexiConnect has continuously researched, collected and linked information to each Section of the entire Constitution, allowing users to access data with convenience in various forms, including documents, infographics, video programs, and podcasts for better improvement of legal and academic works. LexiConnect has been promoted through different channels facilitating users to have convenient and comprehensive access. With a click on a Link or Symbol, data of each category related to Constitutional provisions will be brought to users. This innovation reflects an upgrade of legal and academic work efficiency as well as creative work development through knowledge management allowing inclusive access to the public.

### **Results of the Innovation**

From the development and implementation of **LexiConnect: Integrated Digital Constitution**, it was found that users are highly satisfied with the efficiency and benefits of the innovation. This satisfaction covers the support for legal and academic performance, as well as the convenience provided in searching and accessing constitutional data accurately, rapidly, and comprehensively. Consequently, the service provided to the public, Senators, Committees, parliamentary personnel, internal staff of the Secretariat of the Senate, and stakeholders in the Senate's missions has become more streamlined and of higher quality. During the Project on Knowledge Management Development and Innovation toward Becoming a Smart Organization in the Activity: Strengthening a Learning Culture toward Becoming a Learning and Innovation Organization, the **Senate e-Service and Innovation Showcase 2025 Event** was held from Monday, 25 – Tuesday, 26 of August, 2025, between 09:00 - 16:00 hours at the hall in front of the Senate Chamber, 2nd floor, Parliament Building. The Bureau of Legal Affairs presented the "**LexiConnect: Integrated Digital Constitution**" innovation, which received excellent feedback from Senators. This led to the integration of "**LexiConnect: Integrated Digital Constitution**" into the "**Senate e-Service**" system to enhance the efficiency of services provided to Senators.

Furthermore, from the utilization of the system, it was found that users have a high level of satisfaction regarding the efficiency and benefits of the innovation. The user satisfaction survey results showed a "**Highest**" satisfaction level at **91.7 percent**.

This demonstrates that "**LexiConnect: Integrated Digital Constitution**" can effectively respond to operational and service needs. It increases convenience in searching constitutional data with accuracy, speed, and completeness. Additionally, it can be applied to legal work, academic work, and public service, resulting in the operations of Senators, Committees, parliamentary personnel, and stakeholders in the Senate's missions in more versatile manner and better quality.
